ORDINANCE Nº 015 OF 2016 (November 09)

"BY MEANS OF WHICH OBLIGATIONS ARE DEVELOPED AND REGULATED IN RELATION TO PREVENTION OF HEALTH DAMAGE OF MINORS AND NON-SMOCKING POPULATION CAUSED BY TOBACCO CONSUMPTION, AND PROMOTION FOR QUITTING DEPENDANCY ON TOBACCO AND ITS DERIVATES BY SMOKERS IN THE DEPARTMENT ARCHIPELAGO OF SAN ANDRES, OLD PROVIDENCE, AND KETHLEENA".

THE ASSEMBLY OF THE DEPARTMENT ARCHIPELAGO OF SAN ANDRES, PROVIDENCE AND KETHLEENA, in use of its legal and constitutional faculties, especially the ones given by the articles 13, 47, 54, 68, and 300 of the Political Constitution of Colombia, and in accordance with Laws 1335 of 2009, 47 of 1993, 915 of 2004 and Decree 122 of 1986.

ORDERS

ARTICLE 1. Be developed and regulated the obligations related to the prevention of health damage of minors and non-smocking population caused by tobacco consumption, and be promoted the quitting of dependency on tobacco and its derivates by smokers in the Department Archipelago of San Andres, Old Providence, and Kethleena.

ARTICLE 2. With the purpose of applying Law 1335 of 2009 and, especially article 10 of the Department's Secretariat of Health, just as the Secretariat of Government, with the support of the National Police Force, in the operatives and control and vigilance visits to places and establishments where tobacco and its derivates are sold, the compliance to this disposition will be verified, even in stationary sells or street vending.

It is mandatory that sellers and vendors of tobacco products and their derivates inform through a clear and noticeable announcement inside their establishment or sales point that it is prohibited to sell tobacco products to minors, and pregnant women.

ARTICLE 3. All public buildings under to the Department's public administration must have signaling of places 100% smoke-free and its personnel must be benefitted from tobacco products quitting campaigns that will be programmed in coordination with the ARP hired by the entities.

Moreover, all entities to a Departmental level must spread out in their web pages and other means of communication the text and goodness of Law 1335 of 2009.

ARTICLE 4. The Secretariat of Health must periodically organize training courses on smoking effects so people who are caught smoking in prohibited zones, in accordance to article 24 o Law 1335 of 2009, the one that will be derogated once Law 1801 of 2016 is valid, in this case will be applied the article 22 of the just mentioned rule, will be penalized pedagogically as it corresponds.

ARTICLE 5. The Department's educational institutions must develop tobacco prevention campaigns, under the direction of the Department's Secretariat of Education and Secretariat of Health, through its inclusion in their Institutional Education Programs (PEI) and curricular plans.

ARTICLE 6. When a worker from the educational system of the Department's Hospital Network comes upon a boy, a girl or an adolescent person is consuming tobacco, they must refer immediately to the closest Health System (EPS) to start the adequate treatment in company of their parents.

ARTICLE 7. On May 31, World's Tobacco day, declared by the WHO, the Department's Administration will develop awareness campaigns on tobacco consumption risks and the alternatives there are to quit the habit.

This day, or the closest working day, all educational institutions must promote a reflection upon the dangers to health that smoking causes, the one that must involve all the educational community (teachers, directives, students, parents, and surrounding community).

ARTICLE 8. The ordinance hereby derogates all previous ordinances and all the dispositions that may be contrary. The ordinance hereby goes into effect from the moment it is sanctioned and published.
